#### **Financial Needs of Emmaus Ministries**

Everybody involved in Protea Emmaus is a volunteer and nobody is paid for any services offered to our community. All our expenses need to be covered by event fees, fundraisers, things we can sell, or by donations.

Our expenses include accounting and bank fees, equipment and consumables - stationary, team manuals, tea, coffee, and the like.

Our oversight body Emmaus Ministries South Africa (EMSA) who look after the Emmaus Ministries programs and the 11 communities in South Africa likewise have operating expenses that need to be covered.

If you believe that this is a ministry worth supporting you can donate on a once off, or a monthly basis to help cover these costs.

You can deposit money directly into our bank account, or you can sign up for a debit order run by EMSA where our community gets 70% of your contribution and EMSA gets the remaining 30%. These forms are available on the EMSA website (www.emsa.org.za)

#### Blessed to be a blessing to others!

A pastor tells the story of teaching his children to share.

Every Saturday he would bring sweets home for his three children and there was two ways he could give the sweets to them. One way was to divide them equally and give each child their share. The other way was to give all the sweets to one child and ask that child to share the sweets in a way that they thought was fair.

The first way resulted in peace in the pastor's house, but it didn't teach his children anything about living as a Christian.

The second way often resulted in conflict, especially if the bag of sweets was mixed and not easily divisible by three, but it eventually resulted in his children learning to share and consider others. Sometimes the Pastor and his wife were even given a few of the sweets.

This is the way that God often gives His blessings, including financial resources. God gives more to some people than they need so that they can bless others with their excess. When we are generous with what we have, God has the opportunity to bless us in return.

All the believers were together and had everything in common. They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. [Act 2:44-45]

When it comes to paying the fees for the events that we host, we often find that some of the people who would like to be participants or be part of the event team cannot afford the fees.

We try as hard as possible to keep these fees low, but no matter how low they are, the fees are still out of reach for some people. It is heartsore for us when people are excluded from an event because they cannot afford the fees.

There are always people who God has blessed with more financial resources than they need, and we appeal to these Christians to help us to sponsor the fees of those who cannot afford to

pay. We are always grateful for any donations we receive towards fees.
