Theology of Emmaus Ministries

The theology of all of the Emmaus Ministries' programs is broadly Protestant with a Wesleyan flavour. The programs are based on the Bible and emphasise the importance of faith, grace, prayer, the study of Scripture and Christian living.

Beliefs:

- **God**: The one God exists as three persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
- Jesus Christ: The Son of God, who came to earth to save humanity.
- **Salvation:** Salvation is a gift from God that is received through faith in Jesus Christ.
- **The Bible**: The Bible is the Word of God, and the final authority for faith and life.
- **Grace**: God provides the grace that allows people to choose to believe in Jesus Christ.

Emmaus Ministries events are ecumenical and are open to Christians of all denominations. Participants should, however, be aware of, and be comfortable with, the theological basis of the programs.

All of the programs are led in partnership by lay and clergy people. The clergy are responsible for the theological integrity of the events and administration of Holy Communion.

Since 1978, Emmaus Ministries has been renewing Christian disciples and strengthening local churches. Beginning with The Walk to Emmaus, Emmaus Ministries has grown to include Chrysalis (older teens) and Face to Face (older adults) and partners with Journey to the Table (young adults) and Discovery Weekend (middle school students) to offer spiritual support for people at every life stage. The permission to run the Emmaus Ministries' programs in South Africa vests in Emmaus Ministries South Africa (EMSA). EMSA, in turn, oversees the running of these programs in the 11 active communities in South Africa. Programs in South Africa

The South African Emmaus Communities host three of the Emmaus Ministries' events namely. The Walk to Emmaus, Chrysalis and Face to Face.

Each of these programs is broadly modelled on the story of Jesus' journey with two disciples on the Road to Emmaus found in Luke 24: 13-35.

As the disciples walked with Jesus, He taught them from the Scriptures. In a similar way the Emmaus Ministries programs are a journey through the Love of God, faith, grace and Christian living.

The programs have either 14 or 15 talks as their backbone. Five of the talks are based on Grace and these talks are given by clergy people. The remaining talks focus on Christian Living and these talks are given by lay people.

Although these talks broadly follow the same themes in each of the programs, they have been tailored to the life-stage of the participants in each of the programs. For example, one of the Chrysalis talks focuses on relationships; while a Face to Face talk focuses on grief and loss.

On Emmaus Ministries' events, participants will: Sing, reflect, pray, worship, learn, share Holy Communion, participate in small groups, experience God's grace in community and in the world, and understand Christian love in action.
