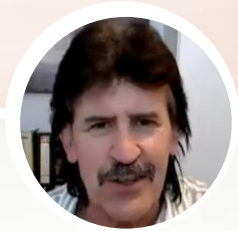

Volunteering



“let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.” [1 Jn 3:18]

Are you using what God has given you?

“We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.” [Rom 12:6-8]

Each of us has been given gifts and talents by God so that we can use them to bless others. The parable of the talents in Matthew 25 makes it clear that if we use these talents we will be trusted with more, but if we bury them God will take our gifts and talents away.

“As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.” [1 Pet 4:10]

As a Christian you need a place to discover, use and grow the gifts God has given you. You should certainly use them in your local church and in your ministry, but often they are not used to their full extent.

Like the servant only given one talent in the parable in Matthew 25 you may not know how to use your gift to serve God and so you may be tempted bury it.

Emmaus Ministries is a great place to join your gift to the gifts others in our community in serving God and blessing our fellow believers. Chances are we need whatever gift God has given you.

Where can I serve?

Emmaus Ministries is a Fourth Day movement. Your Event was just the start of your Emmaus Ministries journey. It is what you do with the blessing God has given you on your Event that is important.
